#### **Lockwood Pedestrian Safety District Advisory Board**

Meeting Minutes recorded and submitted by Zachary Hassler, Advisory Board Secretary Mar. 1, 2023, 7pm

#### **Attendance**

Board members: Pres. Brandy Dangerfield, Vice Pres. Woody Woods, Sec. Zachary Hassler, Pam Ask, Tim Sather

Other guests: Elyse Monat (Active Transportation Planner, City County Planning), Erin Claunch and Lauren Waterton (consultants, Sanderson Stewart), Eric Ler (design engineer, Interstate Engineering)

Board members not in attendance: Carlotta Hecker, Tobin Novasio, Travis Smith

Dangerfield called the meeting to order at 7 p.m. and began by seeking public comment. There were **no public comments** provided.

Ask motioned to approve February minutes. Sather seconded. Motion carried with unanimous voice vote.

Dangerfield opened discussion on the spring 2023 sidewalk construction project from IGA to baseball fields. To address drainage issues near the baseball field, Interstate and Tim Miller suggested adding culverts and grading to initial plans with estimated increased costs of \$35-40k and proposed a budgetary 50/50 split from LPSD funds and normal county funds. Woods said he would like to wait to take action until discussing the cost split with Tim Miller of Yellowstone County. The board refrained from taking any further action and intends to revisit the issue in April.

Claunch and Waterton presented the board with Sanderson Stewart's progress to date on the update of the LPSD plan, including four map exhibits detailing priorities, projects, crossings, and potential future sidewalk networks. Claunch asked if the exhibits represented the desire of the board, and the board affirmed. Waterton projected the draft plan would be ready for board review in April.

Dangerfield opened discussion on the Highway 87E Sidewalk Gap/ Massick property by referring to an exhibit provided by Travis Smith from Performance Engineering. The exhibit shows where an easement would be needed to connect to existing sidewalk geometry. Hassler suggested considering a task order for Sanderson Stewart to complete a survey to determine if routing a sidewalk in the existing MDT right of way would be feasible, north of the existing highway geometry. Woods offered to contact Mike Taylor with MDT to discuss what would be needed. The board intends to revisit at future meetings.

Dangerfield opened discussion on the Transportation Alternatives grant application due April 12<sup>th</sup>. Sather motioned to approve President Dangerfield's actions in support of partnering with Sanderson Stewart to complete the grant application. Woods seconded. Motion carried with unanimous voice vote. This work will be performed under Sanderson Stewart's term contract provisions for on call services.

Woods provided a brief update on TEDD and Billings Bypass related news.

Monat distributed trail counts.


Dangerfield noted a recent email from John Standish. Dangerfield acknowledged the email, and Woods responded.


Dangerfield adjourned the meeting at 8:06 p.m.







### Old Hardin Road Sidewalk

Hourly Averages (February 2023)










Full Week Hourly Avgs






