Lockwood Pedestrian Safety District Advisory Board

Board members not in attendance: Tobin Novasio

Dangerfield called the meeting to order at 7 p.m. and began by seeking public comment. There were **no public comments** provided.

Sather motioned to approve March minutes. Smith seconded. Motion carried with unanimous voice vote.

Lisa Gray with HDR delivered an update via slideshow on the MDT I-90 River Bridge project and local MDT interstate projects generally. Shane Johnson from MDT was also available for questions. MDT expects the River Bridge project to be completed in 2024, and there are multiple other I-90 interstate projects in various stages.

Dangerfield updated the board on the spring 2023 sidewalk construction project from IGA to baseball fields. Askin expects to **start construction at the beginning of May**. Woods said he had talked with Tim Miller of Yellowstone County about whether the LPSD should be paying for county storm drainage facilities like the supplemental culverts suggested by Interstate at the east end of the project. Woods said this remains an ongoing conversation with the county. For now, the project will be constructed as initially conceived without supplemental culverts.

Woods updated the board on the Highway 87E Massick Property sidewalk gap based on his recent conversations with Mike Taylor of MDT. Woods had a photo showing the right of way and what appears to be adequate area to route a sidewalk within the right of way. **Hassler motioned to authorize Sanderson Stewart to provide a scope and estimate to complete this portion of sidewalk. Woods seconded. Motion carried with unanimous voice vote.** Claunch asked Woods if the project would require only an encroachment permit, or if the project would require a full MDT process. Woods said he thought only an encroachment permit would be required based on previous experience building sidewalk on 87E.

Claunch and Dangerfield updated the board on the status of the Transportation Alternatives grant application due to the MPO in April. The county has provided a letter of support; Claunch suggested an LPSD board member also provide a letter of support, and Dangerfield said she would provide the letter. Claunch said the grant application is otherwise ready to go.

The board and Claunch discussed the most recent iteration of the LPSD Transportation Plan update. Woods requested the plan acknowledge the 2003 death of bicyclist J.D. Fasching, and Woods requested the plan note that Old Hardin Rd. is expected to eventually comprise three total lanes that include a center turn lane. **Hassler motioned to approve the plan, contingent on making Woods's requests. Sather seconded. Motion carried with unanimous voice vote.**

Dangerfield updated the board on the annual spring bike give-a-way through the school. She said the board has \$1,900 in PILT funds to give away bikes, helmets, and slap bracelets. She is coordinating



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with Riverstone Health and has Trailnet on board to do the presentation on bike safety. The event is scheduled for May 3.

Woods updated the board on 2024 budget plans, which will have to be set with Jen with Yellowstone County. Woods said the district is in good shape to get our projects done while always striving to spend funds wisely. Dangerfield asked for group discussion on suggested dollar amount for PILT funds. The group settled on requesting \$4,000.

Dangerfield adjourned the meeting at 8:13 p.m.



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

Hourly Averages (January 2021 to March 2023)






Becraft Ln Sidewalk



Hourly Averages (January 2021 to March 2023)







Hourly Averages (March 2023)









Hourly Averages (March 2023)








Old Hardin Road Sidewalk
