Dangerfield called the meeting to order at 7 p.m. and began by seeking public comment. There were **no public comments** provided.

Ler updated the board on the progress of the Old Hardin Road sidewalk project. He had emailed about an elevation issue near the intersection of Old Hardin Road and Clayton Ave, specifically the westernmost approach to the Pape Rentals property. Two options were presented as solutions. Woods instructed Ler to confirm with the property owner that he agreed to option 2 before moving forward with that plan. Novasio motioned to choose option 2 based on owner's approval, Sather seconded the motion, the vote carried 4-for and 1-against.

Ler reported that the contractor planned to resume construction of the sidewalk on September 18th and finish by October 6th. Dangerfield requested that plan be provided in an email from Ler. Woods confirmed the construction delays were justified due to weather conditions and known challenges in concrete supply.

Claunch reported he will contact the owner of the home at the Massick Sidewalk Gap to inform him of the plans for the sidewalk construction.

Monat distributed the trail count results.

Claunch had reported that the TA Grant Application was officially approved via email, August 6th. The next step will be up to MDT to choose an engineer for the project.

Dangerfield adjourned the meeting at 7:42pm.
