MAJOR HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

Major Holiday Schedule for Local Vicinity

Major holidays shall be identified as follows:

Easter Sunday Memorial Day Weekend Independence Day Weekend Labor Day Weekend Halloween Thanksgiving Weekend Christmas Eve Day & Christmas Eve Christmas Day

EASTER SUNDAY

Father shall have the child(ren) beginning at 9:00 a.m. on Sunday during ODD numbered years, and Mother shall have the child(ren) during EVEN numbered years.

MEMORIAL DAY WEEKEND

Mother shall have the child(ren) beginning at 5:00 p.m. on Friday until 5:00 p.m. on Monday during EVEN numbered years, and Father shall have the child(ren) during ODD numbered years.

INDEPENDENCE DAY WEEKEND

Father shall have the child(ren) beginning at 5:00 p.m. on July 3 until 9:00 a.m. on July 5 during EVEN numbered years, and Mother shall have the child(ren) during ODD numbered years. If July 4 falls in conjunction with the parent's scheduled weekend, the extended weekend will be honored.

LABOR DAY WEEKEND

Mother shall have the child(ren) beginning at 5:00 p.m. on Friday until 5:00 p.m. on Monday during EVEN numbered years, and Father shall have the child(ren) during ODD numbered years.

HALLOWEEN

Father shall enjoy this evening with the child(ren) during ODD numbered years, and Mother shall enjoy this evening with the child(ren) during EVEN numbered years.

THANKSGIVING WEEKEND

Father shall have the child(ren) beginning at 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday until 5:00 p.m. on Sunday during EVEN numbered years, and Mother shall have the child(ren) during ODD numbered years.

CHRISTMAS EVE DAY

Mother shall have the child(ren) beginning at 5:00 p.m. on the day school recesses for Winter Break until 9:00 a.m. on Christmas Day during EVEN numbered years, and Father shall have the child(ren) during ODD numbered years.

CHRISTMAS DAY

Father shall have the child(ren) beginning at 9:00 a.m. on Christmas Day until 9:00 a.m. on December 30 during EVEN numbered years, and Mother shall have the child(ren) during ODD numbered years.

MOTHER'S DAY

Mother shall have the child(ren) each Mother's Day.

FATHER'S DAY

Father shall have the child(ren) each Father's Day.

CHILD(REN)'S BIRTHDAYS

The parents shall alternate the child(ren)'s birthdays. Mother shall enjoy this day during ODD numbered years, and Father shall enjoy this day during EVEN numbered years.

The **MAJOR HOLIDAY SCHEDULE** shall take precedence over the regular Parenting Schedule. The regular Parenting Schedule shall resume at the conclusion of each Holiday.

Any changes to this schedule should be **MADE IN WRITING**, witnessed and signed by both parents in the presence of a Notary, with each parent having a copy in their possession prior to the affected dates.

Parents may wish to alter this recommended schedule based on their personal preferences, but must do so **ONLY** when both parents mutually agree and that agreement is represented in the final Parenting Plan.
