

RESOLUTION NO. 21-85
RESCINDING RESOLUTION 21-39 & 21-44
RESCINDING STAGE I & STAGE II FIRE RESTRICTIONS

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Yellowstone County passed Resolution 21-39 on June 15, 2021, enacting a burning ban and Stage I fire restrictions and Resolution 21-44 on June 22, 2021, enacting a burning ban and Stage II fire restrictions; and

WHEREAS, conditions have changed in Yellowstone County with cooler temperatures and much needed precipitation reducing the fire hazard; and

WHEREAS, citizens may need to burn before the winter season.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:


- 1) Resolution No. 21-39 passed on June 15, 2021, is hereby rescinded.
- 2) Resolution No. 21-44 passed on June 22, 2021, is hereby rescinded.
- 3) Citizens, Farmers and Ranchers can commence burning with an approved burning permit issued by the On-line Burn Permitting system administered by the County Fire Warden's office and following the procedures on the permit.

It is effective at 12:01am on the 15th day of September 2021.






