If you make a mistake or change your mind, exchange your ballot for a new one.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">VOTE IN ALL COLUMNS</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">TOWN OF BROADVIEW REFERENDUM ON ORDINANCE NO. 35 (VOTE IN ONE OVAL)</p> <p>Summary: Initiative Measure 190 (I-190) was approved by the electors of Yellowstone County in the general election on November 3, 2020, legalizing possession and use of marijuana for adults over the age of 21 as well as certain marijuana businesses. The Montana Legislature passed House Bill 701 in 2021 and modified provisions of I-190 providing an option for electors to consider prohibition of the seven categories of marijuana businesses. This ballot measure asks voters to approve or disapprove the Town's proposed Ordinance making it illegal for marijuana businesses to operate in the Town of Broadview. The possession of medical or recreational marijuana will remain legal as provided by Montana law.</p> <p>Proposal: The Town Council has proposed an Ordinance to prohibit all marijuana businesses within the Town of Broadview and passed Resolution 23-01 to submit this ballot to the voters. The proposed Ordinance prohibits marijuana businesses which are defined as "a cultivator, manufacturer, adult-use dispensary, medical marijuana dispensary, combined-use marijuana licensee, testing laboratory, marijuana transporter, or any other business or function that is licensed" by the Department of Revenue.</p> <p>Shall marijuana businesses be permitted within the limits of the Town of Broadview?</p> <p><input type="radio"/> FOR prohibiting all marijuana businesses within the Town of Broadview.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> AGAINST prohibiting all marijuana businesses within the Town of Broadview.</p>
