LAUREL SCHOOL DISTRICT #7-70 ELEMENTARY SCHOOL BOND ELECTION

Shall the Board of Trustees of Elementary School District No. 7-70 (Laurel), Yellowstone and Carbon Counties, Montana (the "Elementary District") be authorized to sell and issue general obligation bonds of the Elementary District in one or more series in the aggregate principal amount of up to Fifty-Seven Million and No/100 Dollars (\$57,000,000.00), bearing interest at rates to be determined at the time of the sale, payable semiannually, during a term as to each series of bonds of not more than twenty (20) years, for the purpose of paying the costs of designing, constructing, equipping, and furnishing improvements to accommodate student enrollment, enhance educational opportunities, and address deferred maintenance needs to include constructing a new elementary school building on Elementary District property located at the Mogan soccer fields off Alder Avenue near the middle school, to include classrooms, a library/media area, a kitchen and commons area, a gymnasium, support spaces, and associated site improvements, such as parking, access drives, and playgrounds; improving the West Elementary School, to include constructing classrooms and a new gymnasium, remodeling special education spaces, commons area, and support spaces, and related building and site improvements; demolishing the Graff Elementary School building and associated site work; and, to the extent bond proceeds are available after paying for the above improvements, repurposing the South Elementary School building for use as administration offices, meeting space, and storage; related costs and improvements; and paying costs associated with the sale and issuance of the bonds?
