BILLINGS HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT #2 BUILDING RESERVE FUND SAFETY LEVY

Shall the Trustees of Billings High School District No. 2 be authorized to annually levy 6.9 mills, being approximately \$2,520,000, each year in the Building Reserve Fund for the purpose of planning for improvements to and maintenance of school and student safety; programs and operational expenses to support school and student safety and security; installing or updating security-related facility improvements; and installing or updating response systems using contemporary technologies?

Passage of this proposal will increase the annual taxes on a home with an assessed market value of \$100,000 by approximately \$9.31 and on a home with an assessed market value of \$300,000 by approximately \$27.94 and on a home with an assessed market value of \$600,000 by approximately \$55.89. An increase in property taxes may lead to an increase in rental costs. The durational limit of the levy is intended to be permanent.

CANYON CREEK SCHOOL DISTRICT #4 GENERAL FUND MILL LEVY

Shall the board of trustees be authorized to impose an increase in local taxes to support the general fund in the amount of one hundred and thirty-six thousand and one DOLLARS and forty-seven CENTS (\$136,001.47) per year which is approximately 19.27 mills, for the purpose of: offsetting learning costs, salaries, and operations?

Passage of this proposal will increase the taxes on a home with a market value of \$100,000 by approximately \$26.73 and on a home with a market value of \$300,000 by approximately \$80.19 and on a home with a market value of \$600,000 by approximately \$160.38. Please note that an increase in property taxes may lead to an increase in rental costs. The durational limit of the levy is permanent once approved by the voters, assuming the district levies that amount at least once in the next five years.
