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2 The following Resolution, introduced by Commissioner  
3 Bary, who moved its adoption, was seconded  
4 by Commissioner Williams, and was unanimously  
5 passed and adopted.

6 A RESOLUTION creating Rural Special Improvement District  
7 No. 160, being a thickly populated district in Yellowstone  
8 County Montana, designating the boundaries thereof, as  
9 designated and defined in the Resolution of Intention heretofore  
10 passed and adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of said  
11 county on the 27th day of May, 1952, which said Resolution of  
12 Intention, now on file in the office of the county clerk of  
13 said county, declared it to be the intention of the said Board  
14 of County Commissioners to create Rural Special Improvement  
15 District No. 160.

16 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of said county  
17 gave notice of the passage of the said Resolution of Intention by  
18 causing the same to be published in two issues of the Billings  
19 Times, a weekly newspaper published nearest to the place where  
20 said Rural Special Improvement District No. 160 is to be  
21 created; and also caused to be posted within the boundaries of  
22 such district a copy of such notice in three public places, and a  
23 copy of such notice to be mailed to every person, firm, or corpo-  
24 ration owning property within the proposed district at their last  
25 known place of residence upon the same day that such notice was  
26 first published and posted, the first publication of this notice  
27 being on the ~~29th~~ day of ~~May~~, 1952. A copy of said notice and  
28 proof of its posting, publishing and mailing is on file with the  
29 County Clerk of this county and is indential with the notice  
30 prescribed and set forth in the Resolution of Intention. This  
31 said notice described the general character of the improvement so  
32 proposed to be made and contained the estimated cost thereof and

1 designated June 16, 1952, at 11:00 o'clock a. m. as the time when,  
2 and the office of the Board of County Commissioners in the court-  
3 house at Billings, Montana, as the place where the said Board would  
4 hear and pass upon all protests that might be made against the  
5 making of such improvement or the creation of such district and the  
6 said notice referred to the Resolution of Intention on file in the  
7 office of the county clerk for the description of the boundaries of  
8 such improvement district, and the number of said district was  
9 stated in said notice.

10 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of said  
11 county met in regular session on the said 16th day of June, 1952  
12 at the time and place stated in said notice, and Nora Peterson  
13 having filed her written protest against the inclusion of her  
14 lands (the north 1 acre of the south 2 acres of Lot 4 of Clark  
15 Subdivision) within said district, and appeared in person and  
16 testified in support thereof, said matter was taken by the Board  
17 under advisement.

18 After due consideration the Board finds that her said  
19 protest is insufficient and should be overruled, and that the  
20 public interest requires the creation of said Rural Special  
21 Improvement District No. 160.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Board of  
23 County Commissioners of Yellowstone County, Montana:

24 1. That the protest of Nora Peterson be, and the  
25 same hereby is, overruled; and that the Board of County  
26 Commissioners have acquired jurisdiction to order the proposed im-  
27 provement; that there is hereby created a rural special improvement  
28 district described as Rural Special Improvement District No. 160  
29 in Yellowstone County, Montana; that the general character and  
30 purpose of the improvement to be made in said district are as  
31 follows:

32 To install a six-inch water main, or larger main, as  
follows: beginning at the existing water main on Belknap Avenue

1 at the intersection of Nall Avenue, thence South along Nall  
2 Avenue to the southern boundary of Clark Subdivision, Yellowstone  
3 County, Montana.

4 2. That the payment for the work and labor and  
5 materials to be furnished in making improvements shall be met by  
6 the execution and delivery of coupon bonds drawn against the  
7 funds of said Rural Special Improvement District No. 160.

8 3. That the name of the engineer who is to have  
9 charge of said work is T. W. Hurdle, County Surveyor of Yellow-  
10 stone County, Montana.

11 4. That the boundaries of said improvement district  
12 shall be, and the same are hereby declared to be the same as are  
13 described and set forth in the aforesaid Resolution of Intention  
14 adopted May 27, 1952, which said Resolution of Intention is on  
15 file in this matter in the office of the County Clerk of said  
16 County, and to which reference is hereby made for further  
17 particulars.
