

1 RURAL SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 301

2 Resolution Creating

3 The following Resolution introduced by Commissioner

4 Raney Williams, who moved its adoption, was seconded by  
5 Commissioner Williams, and was unanimously adopted;

6 WHEREAS, a Resolution of Intention to create Rural Special  
7 Improvement District No. 301, being a thickly populated district  
8 in Yellowstone County, Montana, designating the boundaries thereof,  
9 as designed and defined in the Resolution of Intention heretofore  
10 passed and adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of said  
11 County of Yellowstone, on the 25 day of August, A.D., 1955  
12 which said Resolution of Intention, now on file in the office of  
13 the County Clerk of said County, declared it to be the intention  
14 of said Board of County Commissioners to create Rural Special  
15 Improvement District No. 301;

16 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of said  
17 County gave notice of the passage of the said Resolution of  
18 Intention by causing the same to be published in two issues of  
19 the Billings Times, a weekly newspaper published nearest to the  
20 place where said Rural Special Improvement District No. 301 is  
21 to be created; and also caused to be posted within the boundaries  
22 of such district, a copy of such Notice in three (3) public  
23 places, and a copy of such Notice to be mailed to every person,  
24 firm or corporation owning property within the proposed district,  
25 at their last-known place of residence, upon the same day that  
26 such Notice was first published and posted, the first publication  
27 of this Notice being on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, A.D.,  
28 1955. A copy of said Notice and proof of its posting, publish-  
29 ing and mailing is on file with the Clerk and Recorder of this  
30 County and is identical with the Notice prescribed and set forth  
31 in the Resolution of Intention. This said Notice described the  
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1 general character of improvements so proposed to be made and  
2 contained the estimated cost thereof, and designated the 12<sup>d</sup>  
3 day of September, A.D., 1955, at 10:30 o'clock, 2 M.,  
4 as the time when, and the office of the said Board of County  
5 Commissioners in the Courthouse at Billings, Montana, as the  
6 place where the said Board would hear and pass upon all protests  
7 that might be made against the making of such improvement or the  
8 creation of such district and the said Notice referred to the  
9 Resolution of Intention on file in the office of the County  
10 Clerk for the description of the boundaries of such Improvement  
11 District, and the number of said Improvement District was stated  
12 in said Notice;

13 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of said County  
14 having this day met in regular session, at the time and place  
15 stated in the said Resolution of Intention and said Notice of  
16 the time for the hearing of protests against the creation of the  
17 said proposed district and against the making of said improvement,  
18 and it appearing that the public interest requires the creation  
19 of said Rural Special Improvement District No. 301;

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of  
21 County Commissioners of Yellowstone County, Montana:  
22 1. That the Board of County Commissioners have acquired  
23 jurisdiction to order the proposed improvement; that there is  
24 hereby created a Rural Special Improvement District described as  
25 Rural Special Improvement District No. 301, in Yellowstone County,  
26 Montana; that the general character and purpose of the improve-  
27 ment to be made in said District is as follows:

28 To provide for the installation of storm sewer mains  
29 to drain surface waters from the lands inside said  
30 district as follows, to-wit:

31 475 feet of 24 inch concrete pipe extending from the  
32 intersection at North 11th Street and 3rd Avenue  
the Yellowstone County Fair Grounds to an outlet in  
Alkali Creek;

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- 1 380 feet of 18 inch concrete pipe along 3rd Avenue North from North 12th Street to North 11th Street;
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- 3 380 feet of 12 inch concrete pipe along Third Avenue North from North 13th Street to North 12th Street;
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- 5 380 feet of eight inch concrete pipe along Third Avenue North from North 14th Street to North 13th Street;
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- 7 380 feet of eight inch concrete pipe along North 13th Street from Third Avenue North to Fourth Avenue North;
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- 9 380 feet of eight inch concrete pipe along Fourth Avenue North from North 13th Street to North 14th Street;
- 10
- 11 380 feet of eight inch concrete pipe along North 13th Street from Third Avenue North to 2nd Avenue North;
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- 13 380 feet of eight inch concrete pipe along Second Avenue North from North 13th Street to North 14th Street;
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- 15 760 feet of eight inch concrete pipe along North 12th Street from Third Avenue North to First Avenue North;
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- 17 380 feet of eight inch pipe along North 12th Street from Third Avenue North to Fourth Avenue North;
- 18 760 feet of eight inch concrete pipe along North 11th Street from Third Avenue North to First Avenue North;
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- 20 380 feet of eight inch concrete pipe along North 11th Street from Third Avenue North to Fourth Avenue North;
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- 22 380 feet of eight inch concrete pipe along Fourth Avenue North from North 11th Street to North 10th Street;
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- 24 760 feet of eight inch concrete pipe along North 10th Street from Third Avenue North to First Avenue North;
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- 26 900 feet of ten inch concrete pipe along U. S. Highway No. 10 from Third Avenue North to First Avenue North;
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- 28 350 feet of eight inch concrete pipe along First Avenue North from U. S. Highway No. 10 to North 9th Street;
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- 30 380 feet of eight inch concrete pipe along North 9th Street from First Avenue North to Second Avenue North;
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400 feet of eight inch concrete pipe along U. S. Highway No. 10 from Third Avenue North to Fourth Avenue North, and

400 feet of eight inch concrete pipe southwesterly along Fourth Avenue North From U. S. Highway No. 10.

All together with all necessary manholes, connected inlets and appurtenances.

In all approximately 6,850 linear feet of 8-inch concrete pipe;

In all approximately 900 linear feet of 10-inch concrete pipe;

In all approximately 380 linear feet of 12-inch concrete pipe;

In all approximately 380 linear feet of 18-inch concrete pipe;

In all approximately 474 linear feet of 24-inch concrete pipe;

2. That payment for the work and labor and materials to be furnished in making such improvement shall be met by the execution and delivery of coupon bonds drawn against the funds of said Rural Special Improvement District No. 301;

3. That the name of the engineer who is to have charge of said work is L. R. Sampson, County Surveyor, of Yellowstone County, Montana;

4. That the boundaries of said Improvement District shall be, and the same are hereby declared to be the same as described and set forth in the aforesaid Resolution of Intention adopted on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of August, A.D., 1955, which said Resolution of Intention is on file in this matter in the office of the County Clerk and Recorder of said County of Yellowstone, and to which reference is hereby made for further particulars.
