

RURAL SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 335.

Resolution Creating District

The following resolution, introduced by Commissioner Williams, who moved its adoption, was seconded by Commissioner Barney, and was unanimously passed and adopted:

"A resolution creating Rural Special Improvement District No. 335, being a thickly populated district in Yellowstone County, Montana, designating the boundaries thereof as designated and defined in the Resolution of Intention heretofore passed and adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of said county, which said Resolution of Intention, now on file in the office of the county clerk of said county, declared it to be the intention of the said Board of County Commissioners to create Rural Special Improvement District No. 335.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of said county gave notice of the passage of the said Resolution of Intention by causing the same to be published in two issues of the Billings Times, a weekly newspaper published nearest to the place where said Rural Special Improvement District No. 335 is to be created, and also caused to be posted within the boundaries of such district a copy of such notice in three public places, and a copy of such notice to be mailed to every person, firm or corporation, or the agent of such person, firm or corporation, owning property within the proposed district at his last known place of residence upon the same day that such notice was first published and posted, the first publication of this notice being on the 24th day of May, 1956. A copy of said notice and proof of its posting, publishing and

a mailing is on file with the County Clerk of this county and is identical with the notice prescribed and set forth in the Resolution of Intention. This said notice described the general character of improvements so proposed to be made and contained the estimated cost thereof and designated Monday, the 12th day of June, 1956 at eleven o'clock a.m. as the time when, and the office of the Board of County Commissioners in the courthouse at Billings, Montana, as the place where, the said Board would hear and pass upon all protests that might be made against the making of such improvement or the creation of such district, and the said notice referred to the Resolution of Intention on file in the office of the County Clerk for the description of the boundaries of such improvement district, and the number of said improvement district was stated in said notice.

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of said county having this day met following continuance of the regular session at the time and place stated in the said Resolution of Intention and said notice of the time for the hearing of protests against the creation of the said proposed district and against the making of said improvements, and a protest having been filed with the County Clerk within the time required by law, and it further appearing that the <sup>public</sup> interest requires the creation of said Rural Special Improvement District No. 335,

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it hereby resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Yellowstone County, Montana:

1. That the Board of County Commissioners have acquired jurisdiction to order the proposed improvement; that there is hereby created a rural special improvement

district described as Rural Special Improvement District No. 335, in Yellowstone County, Montana; that the general character and purpose of the improvement to be made in said district are as follows:

To replace the existing steel water main in South Billings Blvd., from the Laurel Road to King Avenue (Riverside Drive), with a twelve inch cast-iron water main, together with all necessary valves, hydrants, and fittings, and also for the purpose of switching over all existing service connections to the existing line, to the new main, in Yellowstone County, Montana.

2. That payment for the work and labor and materials to be furnished in making said improvements shall be met by the execution and delivery of coupon bonds drawn against the funds of said Special Improvement District No. 335.

3. That the name of the engineer who is to have charge of said work is L. R. Sampson, County Surveyor of Yellowstone County, Montana.

4. That the boundaries of said improvement district shall be, and the same are hereby declared to be, the same as are described and set forth in the aforesaid Resolution of Intention, adopted the 21st day of May, 1956, except that there shall be excluded therefrom the following tract of land, for good cause shown,

Excepting that portion of Lot 6 described as follows, beginning at the North East corner of said Lot 6, thence running southerly along the East line of Lot 6 a distance of 306.25 feet, thence westerly parallel to and 246.75 feet north of the south boundary of Lot 6, to a point on the West line of Lot 6, thence Northerly 49.15 feet along the West line of Lot 6 to the North West corner of Lot 6, thence Northeasterly 454.7 feet to the point of beginning,

which said Resolution of Intention is on file in this matter
