

RESOLUTION CREATING
RURAL SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 363

A The following Resolution introduced by Commissioner Barney, who moved its adoption, was seconded by Commissioner Williams, and was unanimously adopted;

WHEREAS, a resolution of intent to create Rural Special Improvement District No. 363, a district in a thickly populated locality outside of the limits of the City of Billings, Yellowstone County, Montana, for the purpose of constructing and maintaining a water system therein, and said Resolution designating the number of said district, describing the boundaries thereof, designating L. R. Sampson as the engineer in charge of said work, and estimating the approximate cost thereof as \$10,050, was heretofore adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of Yellowstone County, Montana, on Thursday, October 11, 1956, and ;

WHEREAS, said Board gave notice of the passage of said Resolution of Intent by causing a Notice of the same to be published in two issues of the Billings Times, a weekly newspaper in said county designated by said Board as the newspaper published nearest to said district, and by posting within the boundaries of said district true copies of the said Notice in three public places, and by mailing a true copy of said Notice to every person, firm or corporation or the agent of such person, firm or corporation, owning property within said district at their last known place of residence on the same day said Notice was first published and posted; and,

WHEREAS, the original of said Notice and proof of its posting, publishing and mailing, is on file with the Clerk and

X County Commissioners in the Courthouse at Billings, Yellowstone County, Montana, as the place where said Board would hear and pass upon all protests that might be made against the making of said improvements and the creating of said district and whereas said Notice referred to the Resolution of Intent on file in the office of said Clerk for the description of the boundaries of said district; and,

WHEREAS, said 12th day of November, 1956, is a legal holiday and said Commissioners did not meet, but postponed said hearing on protests until the 13th day of November, 1956, at 2:30 P.M., and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of said county having met November 13, 1956, at 2:30 p.m. in regular session and no protests having been filed against the creation of said district and said Board having taken the matter of creating said district and the making of said improvements under advisement; and,

WHEREAS, it appears to the Board of County Commissioners of Yellowstone County, Montana, that it is in the public interest and convenience to create said district;

NOW THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Yellowstone County, Montana:

1. That the Board of County Commissioners have acquired jurisdiction to order the proposed improvements; that there is hereby created Rural Special Improvement District No. 363 in Yellowstone County, Montana; that the general character and purpose of the improvements to be made in said district is to install water mains to serve Southwest Billings Subdivision, 4th filing, situated in the W $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16, Township 1 South,

X 2. That payment for the work and labor and materials to be furnished in making such improvements shall be met by the execution and delivery of coupon bonds drawn against the funds of said Rural Special Improvement District No. 363;


3. That the name of the engineer who is to have charge of said work is L. R. Sampson, County Surveyor of Yellowstone County, Montana;

4. That the boundaries of said improvement district shall be, and the same are hereby declared to be the same as described and set forth in the aforesaid Resolution of Intent adopted on the 11th day of October, 1956, which said Resolution of Intent is on file in this matter in the office of the County Clerk and Recorder of said County of Yellowstone, and to which reference is hereby made for further particulars.
