RESOLUTION CREATING RURAL SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 40

The following Resolution introduced by Commissioner Carl Yerrington, who moved its adoption and seconded by G. W. Fenton, was unanimously adopted.

A RESOLUTION creating Rural Special Improvement District No. 40, being a thickly populated district in Yellowstone County, Montana, designating the boundaries thereof, as designated and defined in the Resolution of Intention heretofore passed and adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of Yellowstone County, Montana on the 3rd day of June, A.D. 1938, which said Resolution is now on file in the office of the County Clerk and Recorder of Yellowstone County, Montana to which reference is hereby made; that the said Resolution declared it to be the intention of the Board of County Commissioners of Yellowstone County, Montana to create a rural special improvement district to be No. 40.

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of said County, caused notices of the time for the passage and adoption of the said Resolution of Intention to be published in the Billings Times, a newspaper closest to Rural Special Improvement District No. 40 and a weekly newspaper published in Billings, Yellowstone County, Montana in the manner and form and during the period of time as required by law and has also caused the County Clerk of said County, on the 19th day of May, 1938, that being the day of the first publication of the Notice, to mail to each person, firm or corporation or known agent thereof having property within the proposed district, at the last known address of such person, firm or corporation or agent, a notice of the passage and adoption of such Resolution, giving them Notice of Intention of the Board of County Commissioners to create such Rural Special Improvement District for the purposes therein mentioned and set forth and giving them full, due and timely notice as required by law, which said Notice was published and mailed des-

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cribing the character of the improvements proposed to be made in said District, the estimated cost thereof, setting forth the time and place for the hearing of protests against the creation of proposed District and the making of said improvements and which said Notice also contained references to the number of said Resolution of Intention, giving the boundaries of said proposed District and all particulars and causing copies of said Notice to be posted in Three (3) different public places within the boundaries of the said proposed Rural Special Improvement District, and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of said County having this day met in regular session at the time and place fixed and mentioned in the said Resolution of Intention and set forth in said Notice of the time for the hearing of protests against the creation of the said proposed District and against the making of said improvements, and it appearing that no protests have been filed with the County Clerk and Recorder as required by law, and it further appearing that the public interest and convenience of the said District requires the creation of said Rural Special Improvement District.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF YELLOWSTONE, COUNTY, MONTANA:

stone County, Montana deems itself to have acquired jurisdiction to order the proposed improvements; that there be and there hereby is created a Rural Special Improvement District known and described as RURAL SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 40, in the County of Yellowstone, State of Montana; that the general character and purpose of the improvements to be made in said District are as follows:

To furnish and install and maintain Thirteen (13) business type suspension light posts with highway type luminaire,

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Twenty feet, Six inches (20° 6") from light center, said posts to be placed on each side of the curb of First Avenue North extended from the West line of Section Thirty-four (34), Town-ship One (1) North, Range Twenty-Six (26) East, Yellowstone County, Montana and at intervals of Three Hundred feet (300°) or with staggard distances of One Hundred-Fifty feet (150°) for the purpose of serving the people in said District with an adequate lighting system, said District being a thickly populated locality. For further particulars, reference is hereby made to Resolution of Intention and map of said District on file in the office of the County Clerk and Recorder of Yellowstone County, Montana.

That the name of the engineer who is to have charge of said work is C. E. Durland, County Surveyor of Yellowstone County, Montana.

That the boundaries of said Rural Special Improvement District No. 40 shall be and the same are hereby declared to be the same as are described and set forth in the aforementioned Resolution adopted on the 3rd day of June, 1938 declaring the intention of creating District No. 40 and as was set forth in the Petition requesting the creation of said District which said Petition and Resolution are filed in the office of the County Clerk and Recorder of Yellowstone County, Montana to which references are hereby made for a particular description of said boundaries of the property contained in said District; that the Board of County Commissioners hereby makes reference to said Resolution declaring its intention to create said Rural Special Improvement District No. 40 which said Resolution is for all purposes hereby referred to for further particulars.

A RESOLUTION declaring it to be the intention of the Board of County Commissioners of Yellowstone County, Montana to create rural special improvement district which shall be District No. 40 in a thickly populated locality, outside of the limits of an incorporated Town or City, in Yellowstone County, State of Montana, designating the property to be included in the District, the boundaries thereof, stating the general character and purpose of the improvements to be made therein, the approximate estimated cost of said improvements and the time when, the place where the Board of County Commissioners of Yellowstone County, Montana will hear protests to the making of said improvements and the creation of said District.

WHEREAS The Board of County Commissioners of Yellowstone County, Montana being in regular session and having heretofore on the 26th day of March, 1938 received a Petition signed by at least Sixty Per Cent (60%) of the freeholders affected by the proposed Special Improvement District which said Improvement District is located and includes the following described property located in Yellowstone County, Montana, a strip of land 380 feet in width, the center line of which is the center line of First Avenue North, said strip extending from the West line of Section Thirty-Four (34), Township One (1) North, Range Twenty-Six (26) East, Yellowstone County, Montana, to the East line of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of said Section Thirty-Four (34), also a triangular tract of land in the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section Thirty-four (34), Township One (1) North, Range Twenty-Six (26) East, the boundaries of which tract are more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point where said lines, parallel to and 190 feet North of the

That the public interest and convenience requires 18 and it is deemed necessary to order and create and the Board of 19 20 County Commissioners of Yellowstone County, Montana intends to 21 order and create a rural special improvement district with the 22 number, boundaries, order and character of the improvements to 23 be made as hereinafter set forth. 24 3. It is the intention of the Board of County Com-25 missioners of Yellowstone County, Montana to create a rural special improvement district for the purpose of making special im-26 provements upon, along and embracing and through the lands and 27 property included in the following described and bounded terri-28 tory which are the boundaries of the said Rural Special Improve-29 30 ment District as follows:

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A strip of land 380 feet in width, the

center line of which is the center line of First Avenue North, said strip extend-

4. That the number of said improvement district is hereby designated as RURAL SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 40 of the County of Yellowstone, State of Montana.

That the general character and purpose of the improvements which are to be made will be to install and furnish Thirteen (13) business type suspension light posts with highway type luminaire, Twenty feet (20°) Six Inches (6°) from light center, said posts to be placed on each side of the curb of First Avenue North, extended from the West line of Section Thirty-Four (34), Township One (1) North, Range Twenty-Six (26) East, Yellowstone County, Montana and at intervals of 300 feet or with staggard distances of 150 feet. The location of the posts in said lighting system is set forth in said petition and map which are filed in the office of the County Clerk and Recorder of Yellowstone County, Montana to which reference is hereby made for further

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- 5. That the name of the engineer who is to have charge of said work is C. E. Durland, County Surveyor of Yellowstone County, Montana.
- 6. That the approximate estimated cost of said Improvement District is the sum of Twenty-Six Hundred, Seventy-Five and no/100 Dollars (\$2675.00); that the estimated yearly maintenance of said District is Three Hundred, Seventy-Five and no/100 Dollars (\$375.00), boothx exclusivex of xthex works and xthex works are xthex works and xthex works and xthex works are xthex works and xthex works and xthex works are xth
- 7. That on Friday the 3rd day of June, A.D. 1938 at the office of the Board of County Commissioners of Yellowstone County, Montana at 2:00 P.M., the Board of County Commissioners of Yellowstone County, Montana, intends to create such Rural Special Improvement District and will hear protests to the same at said time and place by any person or persons who are owners, or agents of owners, of any lot or parcel of land within said Improvement District, which is within Fifteen (15) days after the first publication of Notices of the passage of this Resolution, have delivered to the County Clerk and Recorder of the County of Yellowstone, State of Montana, protests in writing against the proposed work or improvements or against the creation of the District to be assessed or both and the persons shall have the right to appear at said time in person or by counsel and show cause, if any there be, why this Resolution should not be finally adopted and why the improvements should not be made.
- 8. The following Notice of the adoption of this Resolution shall be published in a newspaper as required by law and copies of said Notice shall be posted in at least three (3) public places inside the boundaries of said proposed District, to-wit:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That on Monday the 16th day of May, A.D. 1938, the Board of County Commissioners of Yellowstone County, Montana adopted a resolution of intention to create a rural special improvement district for the purpose of making the following improvements in said District.

To install, operate and maintain Thirteen (13) business type suspension street light posts with highway type luminaire, Twenty feet Six inches (20'6") from light center, said posts to be placed on each side of the curb of First Avenue North from the West line of Section Thirty-Four (34), Township One (1) North, Range Twenty-Six (26) East, Yellowstone County, Montana, thence in an Easterly direction on said First Avenue North, at intervals of every 300 feet or with staggard spaces of 150 feet and ending at a point on a triangular tract of land in the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section Thirty-Four (34), Township One (1) North, Range Twenty-Six (26) East, Yellowstone County, Montana for the purpose of serving the people in said District with a street lighting system, said District being in a thickly populated locality and including the following property;

A strip of land 380 feet in width, the center line of which is the center line of First Avenue North, said strip extending from the West line of Section Thirty-Four (34), Township One (1) North, Range Twenty-Six (26) East, Yellowstone County, Montana, to the East line of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of said Section Thirty-Four (34), also a triangular tract of land in the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section Thirty-Four (34), Township One (1) North, Range Twenty-Six (26) East, the boundaries of which tract are more particularly described as follows;

Beginning at a point where said lines, parallel to and 190 feet North of the center line of First Avenue North, intersects the East line of the said Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section Thirty-Four (34), Township One (1)

North, Range Twenty-Six (26) East, extending thence in a Southeasterly direction at right angles to the said parallel lines a distance of 380 feet; thence Southwesterly along a line parallel to said First Avenue North a distance of 220 feet to an intersection with the East line of said South-west Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of said Section Thirty-Four (34); thence North along said East line to the point of beginning, exclusive of public roads and places, in Yellowstone County, Montana.

The estimated cost of said improvement is the sum of Twenty-Six Hundred, Seventy-Five and no/100 Dollars (\$2675.00) exclusive of interest charges, and the estimated yearly maintenance of said District is Three Hundred, Seventy-Five and no/100 Dollars (\$375.00) which said costs and expenses are maintenance costs and are to be assessed against said Special Improvement District. That said resolution is designated as RURAL SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 40 and is on file in the office of the County Clerk and Recorder of Yellowstone County, Montana in the Courthouse, in the City of Billings, Montana, to which reference is hereby made.

That the Board of County Commissioners of Yellowstone County, Montana will be in session at the office of said Board of County Commissioners at the Courthouse in the City of Billings, Montana on Friday the 3rd day of June, A.D 1938 at 2:00 P.M. of said day when and where it intends to create the said Rural Special Improvement District, at which time and place the Board of County Commissioners will hear and pass upon all protests that may be made against the making or maintenance of said improvements or the creation of said District by any person or persons who are owners, or agents of owners of any lot or parcel of land within Fifteen (15) days after the first publication of this Notice, have delivered to the County Clerk of Yellowstone County, Montana, a protest in writing against the proposed work or against the creation of said proposed improvements or both

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and they shall have the right to appear at said time in person or by counsel and show cause, if any there be, why the improvement district should not be created.
