

A RURAL SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 520
AS AMENDED

RESOLUTION CREATING DISTRICT

The following resolution, introduced by Commissioner Boberts, who moved its adoption, was seconded by Commissioner McClintock, and was unanimously passed and adopted:

"A resolution creating Rural Special Improvement District No. 520, as amended, being a thickly populated district in Yellowstone County, Montana, designating the boundaries thereof as designated and defined in the Resolution of Intention heretofore passed and adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of said county, which said Resolution of Intention, now on file in the office of the County Clerk of said County, declared it to be the intention of the said Board of County Commissioners to create Rural Special Improvement District No. 520, as amended.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of said County gave notice of the passage of the said Resolution of Intention by causing the same to be published in two issues of the Billings Times, a weekly newspaper published nearest to the place where said Rural Special Improvement District No. 520 is to be created, and also caused to be posted within the boundaries of such district a copy of such notice in three public places, and a copy of such notice to be mailed to every person, firm or corporation, or the agent of such person, firm or corporation, owning property within the proposed district at his last known place of residence upon the same day that such notice was first published and posted, the first publication of this notice being on the 23rd day of May, 1968. A copy of said notice and proof of its posting, publishing and mailing is on file with the County Clerk of this county and is identical with the notice prescribed and set forth in the Resolution of Intention. This said notice described the general character of

improvements so proposed to be made and contained the estimated cost thereof and designated Tuesday, the 11th day of June, 1968 at 10:00 o'clock A.M. as the time when, and the office of the Board of County Commissioners in the Courthouse at Billings, Montana, as the place where, the said Board would hear and pass upon all protests that might be made against the making of such improvement or the creation of such district, and the said notice referred to the Resolution of Intention on file in the office of the County Clerk and Recorder for the description of the boundaries of such improvement district, and the number of said improvement district was stated in said notice.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of said county having this day met in regular session at the time and place stated in the said Resolution of Intention and said notice of the time for the hearing of protests against the creation of the said proposed district and against the making of said improvements, and no protests having been filed with the County Clerk within the time required by law, or at all; ^{OR SAID PROTESTS HAVING BEEN DENIED} and it further appearing that the public interest requires the creation of said Rural Special Improvement District No. 520, as amended,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Yellowstone County, Montana:

1. That the Board of County Commissioners have acquired jurisdiction to order the proposed improvement; that there is hereby created a rural special improvement district described as Rural Special Improvement District No. 520, as amended, in Yellowstone County, Montana; that the general character and purpose of the improvement to be made in said district are as follows:

Installation of a six (6) inch water main in Franklin Lane a distance of approximately 315 feet West from the intersection of Franklin Lane with Riverside Road, Yellowstone County, Montana, together with all necessary hydrants, valves and fittings.

2. That payment for the work and labor and materials to

be furnished in making said improvements shall be met by the execution and delivery and proceeds from the sale of coupon bonds drawn against the funds of said Special Improvement District No. 520.


- 3. That the name of the engineer who is to have charge of said work is MUELLER ENGINEERING, Billings, Montana.
- 4. That the boundaries of said improvement district shall be, and the same are hereby declared to be, the same as are described and set forth in the aforesaid Resolution of Intention, adopted May 21, 1968, which said Resolution of Intention is on file in this matter in the office of the County Clerk and Recorder of Yellowstone County, Montana, in the Courthouse at Billings, Montana, and to which reference is hereby made for further particulars."
