RESOLUTION CHANGING THE BOUNDARIES OF RURAL SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NUMBER 654 TO INCLUDE CRYSTAL SPRINGS SUBDIVISION SECOND AND THIRD FILINGS

WHEREAS, a Petition signed by the required number of Freeholders within the CRYSTAL SPRINGS SUBDIVISION SECOND AND THIRD FILINGS has been filed with the Board of County Commissioners to change the boundaries of rural improvement district 654 to include CRYSTAL SPRINGS SUBDIVISION SECOND AND THIRD FILINGS within Yellowstone County, Montana, and

WHEREAS, the proposed new Boundaries of the changed district are described in Schedule "A" attached hereto, and,

WHEREAS the estimated cost for the maintenance is \$129.29 per lot annually, and

WHEREAS it appears that the CRYSTAL SPRINGS SUBDIVISION SECOND AND THIRD FILINGS should be included in Rural Special Improvement District 654 and that the boundaries should be changed to include said second and third filings, and,

WHEREAS there has been no change in the boundaries of Rural Special Improvement District 654 within the past year,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Yellowstone County, Montana, deeming the public interest and convenience require, and having jurisdiction, hereby changes the boundaries of Rural Improvement District Number 654, Yellowstone County, Montana, described as follows:

1. **DESCRIPTION OF DISTRICT.** The district is described by the exterior boundaries of the following legally described real property:

A tract of land being a portion of Tracts 1, 2 and 3 of Certificate of Survey (COS) No. 2032, located in the West ½ of the Northeast ¼ (W.½ NE¼) of Section 33, T.1S., R.25E., PMM, Yellowstone County, State of Montana, and the extended boundaries are more particularly described on Schedule "A" Attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

- 2. **DESCRIPTION OF IMPROVEMENTS.** The maintenance to be conducted is the same as described in the engineer's estimate attached as Schedule "B" to the Resolution Creating District Number 654 being resolution 96-92.
- 3. **ESTIMATED COSTS.** The estimated costs of the district is \$129.29 per lot annually.
- 4. **DURATION.** The cost estimates are based on a 20-year period but the district shall be deemed to be perpetual in nature unless absorbed and replaced by another district or a municipality.


