
VOTE YOUR BALLOT



- With a blue or black ink pen fill in the oval for each race.
 - Skipping a race will not invalidate your ballot
- To write in a candidate's name, completely fill in the oval next to the line and print the name in the blank space.
- The following are not allowed:
 - An **X**, **v**, or another mark.
 - Crossing out, erasing, or using correction fluid.
 - Any identifying marks on your ballot.
 - Marking more choices than allowed for each race.
- If you make a mistake, request a replacement ballot from your county election office.

PREPARE YOUR BALLOT FOR RETURN

>>



- Place and seal the voted ballot in the secrecy envelope.
- Place and seal the secrecy envelope into the return signature envelope.
- Sign your name on the voter affirmation line on the return signature envelope.
 (Do not sign for another person.)

>> RETURN >> YOUR BALLOT



 Mail your ballot. The Postal Service recommends you mail your ballot at least one week before the election.

(Note: One Forever/First Class Stamp Required)
